FOREWORD

The solos in this collection provide a variety of stylistic material for the drum set player. They go beyond the scope of the first book, **Contest Solos For The Young Drum Set Player** (grades 1-2+), by offering even more challenging repertoire for recital, contest, jury and study. Many aspects of solo drum set playing are encompassed in these pieces:

styles: rock, boogaloo-funk, hip-hop, jazz waltz, 5/4 jazz, mambo, samba, etc., and the characteristic rhythms and timbres (tone colors) of each idiom on the drum set.

techniques: playing with sticks (stick shots, press rolls, rim clicks/clave, etc.), brushes, and timpani mallets; pitch-bending, 4-way coordinated independence of hands and feet; fill-in ideas.


musicianship: note reading; phrasing in groups of 2, 4, 8 and 12 measures; time-keeping; ad lib or improvisational space, development of taste, etc.

It is the author's hope that the intermediate drum set player is provided herein with interesting, valuable and enjoyable material for this exciting mode of expression.
