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
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Lesson 10. Inner Leger Lines

(Below Treble and Above Bass)

EXPLANATION: In finding leger notes, always think in terms of LINES. Notice that from line to line there is always a skip of one white key on the piano (or a skip of one letter name). To find leger line notes *under* the treble staff, start at the bottom line (E) and go DOWN. To find leger line notes *above* the bass staff, start at the top line (A) and go UP.



(Note: The line notes and letters are larger.)

DIRECTIONS: Using the chart above, find each note at the keyboard first; then write the letter names in the squares.
