



- (a) The first edition has M.M. ♩ = 138. The Clara Schumann edition has ♩ = 88.
- (b) The first edition has *ped* at the beginning, meaning *con pedale*. The pedal indications in light print are by the editor. The Clara Schumann edition has a pedal indication only on the first count of measures 1, 3, 5, 7, 13 & 15, and a pedal indication from the last half of measure 16 to the end of the piece.
- (c) The *una corda* and *tre corde* indications are from the Clara Schumann edition.
