There will be many of these exercises scattered through the book. Play all these slowly at first, giving special attention to intonation. Tongue precisely and center your tone. Notice which combination fits your valve adjustment best. Valve markings over any four-note group are models. [BE] and [D] mean better slide work in that adjustment.

Play both tongued and slurred.
