

Audience sings third time

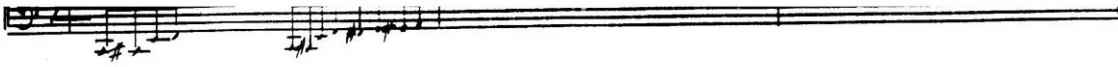
Play first time. Sing second and third times\*
