Geography of the Fingerboard

The division of the fingerboard into six positions of the hand is the creation of François Rabbath. This idea has been thoroughly explicated in his *Nouvelle Technique de la Contrebasse* (three volumes published by Leduc).

The six positions correspond with the natural division of the string into nodal points at fractions of its length. The illustration shows the harmonics and stopped notes found on the G-string at the nodal points.



