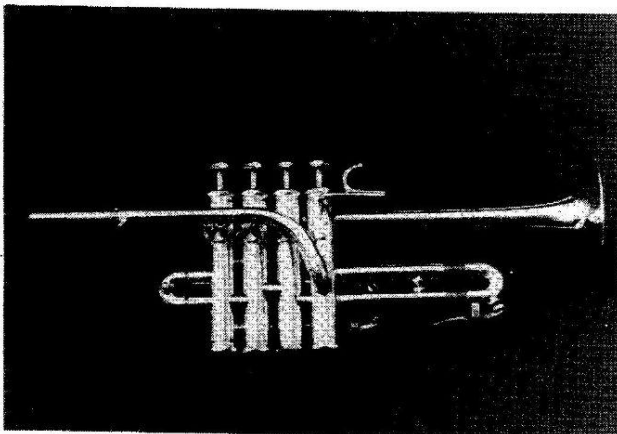
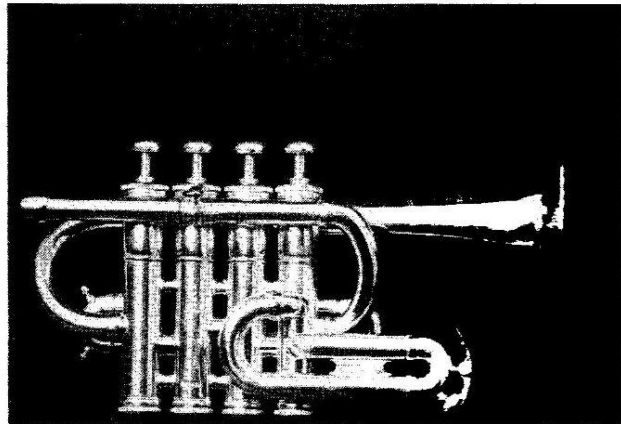

D Trumpet to A Piccolo- up a perfect fourth, down an octave (or down a perfect fifth)

C Trumpet to B-flat Piccolo- up a major second, down an octave (or down a minor seventh)

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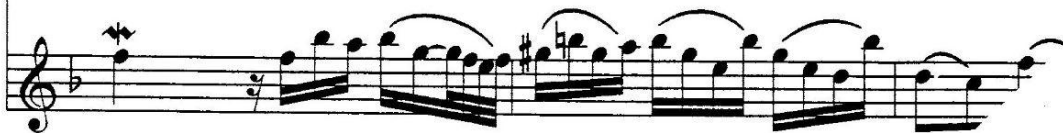
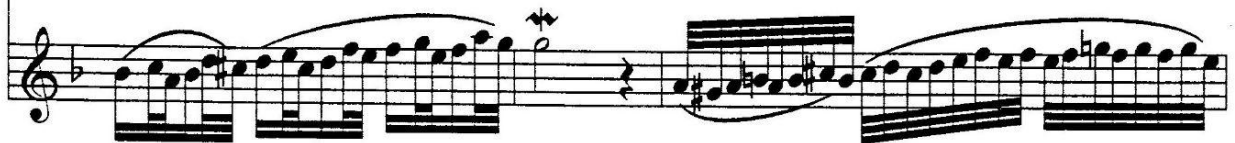
