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About the Music

Triangles was conceived as a recital showcase for the traditional brass trio: trumpet, horn, trombone. The first movement is cast in triple meter and the intervallic movement represents a triangular formation as each voice enters separately. These note motives are later developed into 16th note patterns.

The second section, Lamentoso, is set in a 4/8 meter, giving the eighth note a slow, single beat. The movement is designed to highlight the rich sonority of the three instruments with alternating melodic motives. A brief staccato theme appears at measure 24, providing contrast, followed by a quasi-cadenza in the trumpet part. The slow melodic theme re-appears to conclude the movement.

Section three, the Allegro Con Brio, confirms the triadic nature of the trio, beginning with a short motif in the trombone and followed throughout with interchanging rhythmic configurations in all three instruments.
