# About This Book

This progressive songbook series is designed to guide and create knowledgeable, developing singers as they seek awareness and study the art of singing. Each of the books focuses on different ages and stages of development.

Level 1 is designed to be the discovery point for early and beginning singers. Young singers will dig deeper into foundational skills required for nurturing and enhancing the coordination of mind, body, musicality, and heart in singing. Techniques are introduced through fun and engaging exercises to assist with refinement and practice.

In these pages you will find a scaffolding of songs and strategies, eliminating the potential challenges of repertoire selection and lesson planning for both singer and teacher. Original, traditional, and popular songs are included to introduce a wide variety of styles. The carefully devised objectives lead naturally to capable outcomes for kids, allowing for confidence building and mastery of skills.

Basic singing and musical skills including expression, articulation, diction, form, pitch matching, pitch motion, vocal exploration (registration), rhythm, and performance etiquette are introduced in progressive order. A "Singer's Choice" activity page at the end of the book guides young singers working on additional selections.





Singing from memory shows confidence and helps the performer connect with their audience.


A great way to help you memorize your words is to practice singing at home every day!




